

Making a structural cross section IX: a finished product

This page completes our series by showing our cross section with a normal fault inferred from the offset of our correlations and from our recog-

nition of missing section in multiple wells. This cross section is not realistic geologically because the fault is a very-low-angle fault (or our wells are

spaced very closely). Much more commonly, a fault cuts only one well, and finding the fault will depend much more, if not solely, on recognition of missing section.
