

Making a structural cross section VI: correlations

With our logs set up for a cross section as done in Part V of this series, we're ready to make some geological inferences. The

logical first step is to make correlations from well to well by matching patterns. The result suggests a strange-looking monocline between Wells 3

and 4 – but we're having trouble tracing one horizon through that apparent monocline, and the monocline disappears deeper down.
